OUR PROGRAMS

Our programs were created to provide the youth of Waterbury with a positive and safe place to attend during non-school hours. Our programs' goal is develop and enhance each youths' individual skills and empower them to become successful leaders in our community!

BRIDGE AFTER SCHOOL

For Waterbury students in grades K-5. Program provides transportation from select schools in Waterbury to the program site. Participants will homework help, mentoring, as well as recreational and educational activities.

MENTOR ME!

For Waterbury students in grades 6-8. Program provides transportation from select schools in Waterbury. Participants lend and receive mentoring and homework help. Program helps develop participants' responsibility, leadership and accountability skills and knowledge.

HIGH SCHOOL INTERNSHIP

High School students within the Waterbury area are eligible to apply for the internship program where students gain real-world work experience while also getting paid for their work. Applications available in August, Interns are required to volunteer 3 hours a week.



YOUTH SPORTS CAMPS

Program teaches the fundamentals of various sports, to boys and girls. Staff is dedicated to teaching all children the fundamentals of the games and help further develop their current skills.

CAMP FIRE SUMMER ENRICHMENT

The camp is a DPH licensed Youth Day Camp for children ages 5-15 in the city of Waterbury and neighboring towns. Provides a variety of activities throughout the summer, such as: sports and recreation, arts and crafts, cooking, and educational activities. Children are required to read each day, and keep a reading log of books they have completed reading. The children also have weekly trips to a local park, pool, movie theater, and a fun field trip at the end of the week!

CHEERLEADERS

For girls ages 7-16. Program teaches girls various cheerleading skills and dances. The team perform in various parades and events throughout the state of Connecticut. Program runs from January-October.



RIVERA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year the organization provides over \$5,000 in scholarship funds to three Waterbury high school or full-time college students. Applications become available in August, and awards are given in April.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES
